The Global War on Terrorism is a multi-theatre war which began following the events of September 11, 2001 encompassing all operations to counter terrorism. About 6,970 service members have lost their lives and 52,802 have been wounded in this war. About 3,410 civilian government contractors have been killed in Afghanistan and Iraq, and 38,953 have sustained work-related injuries.

The Global War on Terrorism (GWOT) Memorial Foundation is the congressionally designated nonprofit organization whose mission is to lead the effort to plan, fund and build the National GWOT Memorial on the National Mall, in Washington, D.C., on a site befitting the historical significance of service in this war. The GWOT Memorial Foundation believes that both service members and civilians who have served in this war, their families and the American people deserve a fitting memorial where our country can learn about, reflect on and honor their endurance and sacrifice.
