OUR FOUNDATION IS LEADING THE WAY



The Global War on Terrorism Memorial Foundation is the congressionally-designated nonprofit entrusted with overseeing the fundraising, design, site selection, and construction of a memorial on the National Mall in Washington, D.C. President George W. Bush serves as the Foundation's Honorary Chairman alongside a distinguished board of directors.

In 2017, President Trump signed into law legislation authorizing the establishment of a Global War on Terrorism Memorial on federal land in Washington, D.C. In 2021, President Biden signed into law legislation authorizing the construction of a Memorial on the National Mall. But much work ahead remains. Constructing a Memorial is a long and expensive process. The Foundation is solely responsible for accepting contributions and paying the expenses for establishing the Memorial, which we estimate at \$100 million dollars.
